

Lists of LGSPA initiatives

- Local Government Management
 - Support LGUs in formulating their Comprehensive Development Plan- Executive and Legislative Agenda (CDP-ELA) in a participatory manner with various stakeholders. The CDP-ELA identifies the cities'/municipalities' top priorities for the three-year term of their mayors. LGSPA also assists in the CDP-ELA fund sourcing, monitoring and evaluation.
- Shelter
 - Assist LGUs in crafting shelter plans, enacting supporting shelter codes and implementing shelter strategies.
- WASH
 - Support LGUs in providing residents with equitable access to potable water supply, sanitation, and hygiene services (WASH) through installing appropriate community-based water systems, and strengthening Municipal Water Task Forces (MWTFs) and Water and Sanitation Associations (WSAs), among other activities.
- Education
 - Support LGUs in strengthening their Local School Boards to implement priorities in education agendas, harnessing the Special Education Fund, supporting initiatives like daycare, preschools, vocational-technical education, and promoting adult literacy through agriculture. These strategies expand the scope of response to challenges in ARMM beyond basic education.
- Local Economic Development
 - Directly support LGUs in developing their specific enterprises and industries and also indirectly facilitate local economic development through enabling the expansion and institutionalization of agencies like DTI-ARMM.
- Local Agricultural Development and Halal Industry
 - Assist LGUs in mainstreaming *halal* standards and processes in their agricultural support production activities, as well as helping LGUs form clusters to consolidate agriculture produce volume requirements and/or

encourage reciprocity where one locality may provide inputs to the others in the value chain.

➤ Solid Waste Management

- Support LGUs in making operational and institutionalizing their ecological solid waste management (ESWM) systems through coaching the Municipal Solid Waste Management (SWM) Boards, Barangay SWM Committees, and City Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) to ensure that waste management services are delivered in a responsive and sustainable manner.

➤ LGU Financial Management

- Support LGUs in strengthening financial and fiscal management systems through intensive information and education campaigns about their importance, exposure to good LGU practices, and cross-learning programs through LGU-to-LGU exchanges and peer-to-peer coaching approaches.

➤ Gender and Development

- Support LGUs in mainstreaming gender equality through the following entry points: enterprise development, shelter, violence against women and children (VAWC), social services and leadership. In the process, LGUs and other stakeholders like women groups and local Muslim Religious Leaders (MRLs) become engaged in promoting the Code of Muslim Personal Laws (CMPL) and how it can be tapped to be more supportive of gender rights.

➤ Enabling Environment

- Support ARMM Regional Government (ARG) in regional development planning and policy development through the formulation of the ARMM Regional Executive and Legislative Agenda (ARELA) and integrating this with the CDP-ELA priorities of LGUs. Assist in monitoring progress towards achieving regional targets.
- Support ARG in coordination of national government, donor and non-government organization (NGO) assistance.
- Support DILG-ARMM in the provision of technical support to LGUs, in the promotion and use of the Local Governance Performance Measurement System (LGPMS). Helps to build the capacity of DILG-ARMM in the area of knowledge management and to strengthen links between the local, regional and national governments.

- Support DTI-ARMM and DAF-ARMM in strengthening their capacities to link with and coach LGUs in promoting local economic development and local agriculture development through partnerships with national government agencies and the private sector.
- Provide technical assistance to the organizational strengthening of the Muslim Mindanao Halal Certification Board, Inc. (MMHCBI) and in the further development of the Halal industry in ARMM.

➤ Participatory Governance

- Support Civil Society Organizations (CSO) in ARMM to significantly contribute to strengthening democratic and transformative processes in governance through applying alternative community organizing and social mobilization methods.
- Support Bangsamoro CSOs in crafting a Bangsamoro CSO Development Framework through provincial, national consultations and advocacy work..
- Assist CSOs in multi-media approaches to increase the awareness of initiatives in ARMM that promote peace and good governance at the local, regional and national levels.

➤ Peacebuilding

- Support LGUs in strengthening conflict-sensitive and peace promoting initiatives such as Peace Zones, Municipal Peace and Order Councils (MPOCs), Local Conflict Resolution Mechanisms (LCRMs), and in strengthening barangay justice through the Lupong Tagapamayapa (LT).
- Support LGUs in mainstreaming responses to local peace issues as contained in their Integrated Area Community Public Safety Plans (IACSPs), and in mainstreaming Peace and Conflict Impact Assessment (PCIA) in LGU systems and processes.
- Support local groups engaged in peacebuilding activities through the Community Peace Fund and strengthening the role of the Muslim Religious Leaders (MRLs) in promoting good governance and peace and development.
